## **Shillington Lower School - Class news**



### Pixies Preschool

In Pixies we have been learning about harvest. In Outdoor Explorers we made nature crowns out of all the autumn leaves on the school field. The children proudly wore these to the Harvest Festival at the church. The Pixies were incredible at following instructions on our first outing. We have been busy learning where all our fruit and vegetables come from and how it is important to wash all our vegetables and fruit before we eat them.

This week, we have been celebrating Diwali. We began the week by learning what Diwali is and how people celebrate it. The children created their own salt dough Diva Lamps and have been busy making their own Rangoli patterns.

We have also been celebrating Halloween. The children have made fantastic decorations for our classroom and explored pumpkins. We found that the inside of pumpkins felt slimy and sticky. We ended the week by having our own little Halloween disco, you all looked amazing in your costumes. We hope you have a lovely half term break, well done Pixies for a fabulous start to this year.

## **Hedgehogs** -Reception


In Hedgehogs this week we have been celebrating Diwali and Halloween. We learnt all about the Hindu Festival of Light before using watercolours to create rangoli patterns and making Diva Lamps out of clay. The excitement has begun for Halloween as we have enjoyed sensory tuff trays to develop our fine motor skills. We also made bubbly cauldrons using paint and bubbles and completed some spooky maths, including repeating patterns and spider counting. In PE we danced to Halloween themed songs and then relaxed for some Halloween yoga. We are very proud of all that Hedgehogs have achieved in their first half term of school and we are excited to continue our learning when we are back. We hope you all have a lovely half term!



### Squirrels - Year 1 & 2

In Science, we have been learning about properties of materials. We explored which materials may be good for building and making a ship. We thought about which ones are waterproof and strong enough to carry weight on the water. It was great fun to build them!

During Art, we made clay pots inspired by Clarice Cliffe. We made these pots by either the coil or pinch method. This week, we painted them using bright and bold colours in the style of Cliffe. We made sure to use lots of shapes and bold lines.





### Rabbits - Year 3

In English the past few weeks we have been putting together our final edit of Mini Rabbit got Lost. The children have worked hard to edit and improve their story before writing it up neatly. We then shared them with the year 4 children.

In Maths, we have started our addition and subtraction unit. The children have started adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers, the children have started with focusing on one, then tens and then hundreds e.g. 245 + 4 =, 245 + 40 =, 245 + 400=.

This week in Art, the children cured their clay pots to make them strong and shiny. They also did some lovely Mandela mindfulness where the children used their pencils to create different patterns and shading.

#### Barn Owls - Year 4

It has been a fantastic half term in Barn Owl Class. We have worked so hard and learnt so many new things. We have finished our book 'Undefeated'. We have learnt about how a poem can be written in different forms, how images, fonts and sizes can have an impact on the reader but also can be interpreted in many ways. They have learnt about activists and how the values of determination and perseverance helped make the changes of today.

In maths we have finished our maths unit on addition and subtraction. We can confidently add and subtract four-digit numbers, understanding when and why we need to exchange if the column is more than 10. We have also showed perseverance when solving 2 step word problems, identifying which calculation to use to find the answer.

We have finished learning about Ancient Romans. This has been such an interesting topic, and the children have thoroughly enjoyed it. We finished learning about what legacy means and what the legacy was of the Roman Empire in Britain.
